Port of Spain--- The Ministry of Social Development and Family Services joins with the international community on the occasion of World Sight Day on October 13. Celebrated on the second Thursday in October, this year's commemoration encourages persons to **#LoveYourEyes** and highlights that one billion persons are living with vision loss globally, but do not have access to eye care while simultaneously, encouraging those individuals not yet impacted by vision loss, to care for their own eyes.
